

## EMERGENCY INFORMATION

Each household needs to discuss what Emergency Information each household member needs to place into the clear plastic Emergency Envelope.

Complete the Citizens Ambulance Emergency Information card for each member of the household.

Other suggested information:

1. A photo and name to identify each person living in the house; fingerprints of the children living in the house;
2. Type of pets living inside the house and their names;
3. Situational information: for example, if a person in the house may hide if they hear sirens or flashing lights and where would they hide; is a person in the house on oxygen therapy, if so where do they keep the oxygen tanks;
4. Do Not Resuscitate instructions, the location of Advanced Directives, Living Wills, and other emergency information you feel is important.
5. This Emergency Information would be placed in the clear plastic Emergency Envelope with "Emergency Information" in front, then place the plastic Emergency Envelope on your refrigerator for easy access by your household members and emergency personnel.
6. The household members would be responsible for updating the emergency information.
